ENROLLED HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1002

A Concurrent Resolution relating to meat and poultry; and encouraging Oklahomans to consume and enjoy meat and poultry.

WHEREAS, the production of beef, pork, and poultry in Oklahoma contributes \$18 billion annually to the state's economy; and

WHEREAS, animal agriculture and the direct care of livestock is a meaningful way of life to more than 110,000 Oklahomans; and

WHEREAS, there are proven health benefits of eating lean meat and poultry. Research shows that eating lean beef as part of a heart healthy dietary pattern can help maintain normal cholesterol levels. The pork sirloin roast joins the pork tenderloin with this designation as an extra lean cut of meat certified by the Heart-Check Food Certification. Chicken provides vital nutrients such as potassium, magnesium, choline, vitamin B12 and iron; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahomans involved in producing beef, pork, and poultry have a proven track record of sustainability and caring for our state's natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature resolves that meat just tastes good.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature encourages Oklahomans to consume and enjoy meat and poultry for the week beginning March 22, 2021, and as often as they desire.
