Truman 16 immediately recognized and established full diplomatic relations 17 with Israel; and 18 WHEREAS, the State of Israel provided a safe refuge for those 19 who survived the near destruction of European Jewry during the 20 Holocaust; and 2.1 WHEREAS, Israel opened its doors to Jews from all corners of the 22 globe fleeing anti-Semitism and oppression in such countries as 23 Ethiopia, the former Soviet Union, Argentina, Syria, Iraq, and Iran 24 and continues to do so; and

WHEREAS, as an outcome of the Abraham Accords, Israel's peaceful relations across the Middle East now expand beyond Egypt and Jordan to include the United Arab Emirates, Morocco, Bahrain, and Sudan; and

WHEREAS, though Israel is one of the world's smallest countries, it boasts a sophisticated, entrepreneurial economy, is consistently on the cutting-edge of technological advancement, and stands at the forefront of the most innovative research and development in the fields of renewable energy sources, cybersecurity, water management, medicine, and more; and

WHEREAS, Israel is often the first to send humanitarian aid, search and rescue teams, field hospitals, and other emergency supplies to places reeling from natural disasters or responding to tragedy around the world including Turkey, Ukraine, Haiti, Japan, Nepal, Florida, and our own State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, continued cooperation and collaboration between Israel and the United States is vital, especially in the context of rising anti-Semitism, authoritarianism, and security concerns in Europe, the Middle East, and North Africa; and

WHEREAS, the Sooner State in concert with the OKlahoma Israel Exchange (OKIE) has been a steadfast supporter of the unshakeable bond between Israel and the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Oklahoma and the people of Israel have cultivated a warm, unique, and mutually beneficial relationship

1	based on a shared pioneering spirit, common interests, respect,
2	resiliency, and a commitment to help those in need; and
3	WHEREAS, the ties between the State of Oklahoma and Israel are
4	reflected in the many political, cultural, economic, academic, and
5	agricultural exchanges such as those fostered by OKIE that
6	contribute to both our peoples.
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
8	OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
9	CONCURRING THEREIN:
10	THAT the Oklahoma Legislature is honored to recognize the people
11	of Israel on this milestone occasion of the 75th anniversary of
12	Israel's independence.
13	THAT the Oklahoma Legislature extends its collective goodwill
14	and best wishes to the State of Israel and its people for a peaceful
15	and prosperous future.
16	THAT on April 26, 2023, which is the 5th day of Iyar on the
17	Hebrew calendar and the date known in Hebrew as Yom HaAtzmaut or
18	Israel's Independence Day, we celebrate the historic significance of
19	the 75th anniversary of the establishment of the sovereign and
20	independent State of Israel.
