9 AS INTRODUCED

10 A Concurrent Resolution recognizing and celebrating
11 the Fiftieth Anniversary of the Oklahoma Museums
12 Association.

13 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association was established on May
14 24, 1972, with a mission to promote the general welfare of museums
15 and their advancement as educational institutions, as agencies of
16 scientific research, and as cultural centers; to foster continued
17 improvement of the museum profession through the development of high
18 standards of ethics, conduct, education, and scholarly attainments;
19 to increase and diffuse knowledge through meetings, reports, papers,
20 discussions, publications, and media; and to encourage cooperation
21 among Oklahoma museums and those interested in them; and

22 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association currently serves over
23 five hundred museums and cultural organizations which are located in
24 every region of the state and serve as educational institutions,

1 preservation organizations, agencies of scientific discovery, and
2 cultural centers; and

3 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association represents a multitude
4 of disciplines and learning experiences, including art museums,
5 historical societies, historic sites, zoos, aquariums, science
6 centers, botanical gardens, historic houses, natural history
7 museums, children's museums, heritage centers, living history
8 museums, tribal cultural centers, and museums; and

9 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association assists a variety of
10 institutions in responding to community need and audience
11 engagement, professional development for teachers, and education
12 resources for Oklahoma's students; and

13 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association encourages curiosity,
14 enjoyment, and education for every generation and every community;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association has served to bring
17 important recognition of all museums, the growth of professional
18 standards, and training; and

19 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Museums Association serves as a model for
20 state museum associations across the nation gaining recognition as a
21 leader in the field.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
23 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
