The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, 17 the following proposed amendment to Section 23 of Article V of the 18 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows: 19 Section 23. No A. Except as provided for in subsection B of 20 this section, no member of the Legislature shall, during the term 21 for which he or she was elected, be appointed or elected to any 22 office or commission in the State, which shall have been created, or 23 the emoluments of which shall have been increased, during his or her

term of office, nor shall any member receive any appointment from

1	the Governor, the Governor and Senate, or from the Legislature,
2	during the term for which he or she shall have been elected, nor
3	shall any member, during the term for which he or she shall have
4	been elected, or within two years thereafter, be interested,
5	directly or indirectly, in any contract with the State, or any

7	the term for which he <u>or she</u> shall have been elected.
8	B. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit a member
