To protect agriculture as a vital sector of 23 Oklahoma's economy, which provides food, energy, health benefits, 24 and security and is the foundation and stabilizing force of

1	Oklahoma's economy, the rights of farmers and ranchers to engage in
2	farming and ranching practices shall be forever guaranteed in this
3	state. The Legislature shall pass no law which abridges the right
4	of farmers and ranchers to employ agricultural technology and
5	livestock production and ranching practices without a compelling

7	Nothing in this section shall be construed to modify any
8	provision of common law or statutes relating to trespass, eminent
9	domain, or any other property rights.
