L5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L 6	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
L7	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
L 8	the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the
L 9	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
20	Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the
21	initiative, and eight <del>per centum</del> <u>percent (8%)</u> of the legal voters <u>of</u>
22	each county of this state shall have the right to propose any
23	legislative measure, and fifteen <del>per centum</del> <u>percent (15%)</u> of the
24	legal voters of each county of this state shall have the right to

1	propose amendments to the Constitution by petition, and every such
2	petition shall include the full text of the measure so proposed.
3	The second power is the referendum, and it may be ordered (except as
4	to laws necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
5	peace, health, or safety), either by petition signed by five per
6	centum percent (5%) of the legal voters of each county of this state
7	or by the Legislature as other bills are enacted. The ratio and per
8	centum of legal voters hereinbefore stated shall be based upon the
9	total number of votes cast at the last general election for the
10	Office of Governor.
11	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
12	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
13	the following form:

16	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
17	This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends a
18	section pertaining to initiative and referendum petitions. The
19	amendment changes the percentage of legal voters necessary to
20	propose certain petitions from statewide to each county of this
21	state.
