12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
13	AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
14	Section 1. The Oklahoma Legislature of Oklahoma hereby makes an
15	application to Congress, as provided by Article V of the
16	Constitution of the United States of America, to call a convention
17	limited to proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United
18	States of America to set a limit on the number of terms that a
19	person may be elected as a Member of the United States House of
20	Representatives and to set a limit on the number of terms that a
21	person may be elected as a Member of the United States Senate.
22	Section 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
23	transmit copies of this application to the President and Secretary
24	of the Senate of the United States and to the Speaker, Clerk and

Judiciary Committee Chairman of the House of Representatives of the Congress of the United States, and copies to the members of the said Senate and House of Representatives from this State; also to transmit copies hereof to the presiding officers of each of the legislative houses in the several States, requesting their cooperation.

7 Section 3. This application shall be considered as covering the same subject matter as the applications from other States to 8 9 Congress to call a convention to set a limit on the number of terms 10 that a person may be elected to the House of Representatives of the 11 Congress of the United States and the Senate of the United States; 12 and this application shall be aggregated with same for the purpose 13 of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require Congress 14 to call a limited convention on this subject, but shall not be 15 aggregated with any other applications on any other subject. 16

16 Section 4. This application constitutes a continuing 17 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the 18 United States of America until the legislatures of at least two-19 thirds of the several states have made applications on the same 20 subject.
