9	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
10	to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 8C of
11	Article X of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; eliminating income threshold; providing
12	ballot title; and directing filing.
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15	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
16	2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
17	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
18	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
19	the following proposed amendment to Section 8C of Article X of the
20	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
21	Section 8C. A. Despite any provision to the contrary,
22	beginning January 1, $\frac{2005}{2023}$, the fair cash value, as determined
23	by law, on each homestead of an individual head of household whose
24	gross household income from all sources for the preceding calendar

1 year did not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of this 2 section, and which individual head of household who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older, shall not exceed the fair cash value 3 4 placed upon the property during the first year in which the 5 individual head of household was sixty-five (65) years of age or 6 older and had gross household income from all sources which did not 7 exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of this section. Subject to the limitations of this section, the fair cash value 8 9 shall not exceed such amount as long as the individual head of 10 household who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older owns and 11 occupies the property and as long as the gross household income from 12 all sources does not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of 13 this section. If any improvements are made to the property, the 14 fair cash value of the improvements shall be assessed in accordance 15 with law by the county assessor and added to the assessed value of 16 the property. Once the fair cash value of the improvements has been 17 added to the fair cash value of the property, the total fair cash 18 value shall not exceed the revised valuation of the property so long 19 as the individual head of household who is sixty-five (65) years of 20 age or older owns and occupies the property and so long as the gross 21 household income from all sources does not exceed an amount as 22 provided in subsection B of this section. For any individual head 23 of household who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older prior to 24 January 1, 1997, and has gross household income from all sources of

Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) or less in calendar year 1 1996, the fair cash value of the real property shall be the fair 2 cash value placed upon the property on January 1, 1997. If the 3 individual head of household ceases to own and occupy the property 4 5 or if the gross household income from all sources exceeds an amount as provided in subsection B of this section, the fair cash value of 6 7 the property shall be determined as if the provisions of Section 8 of Article X of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma or any 8 9 other provisions relating to a limitation on the fair cash value of 10 locally assessed real property had been in effect during the time 11 the property was valued pursuant to the provisions of this section. 12 B. The income threshold for the gross household income from all 13 sources for an individual head of household under this section shall 14 not exceed the amount determined by the United States Department of 15 Housing and Urban Development to be the estimated median income for 16 the preceding year for the county or metropolitan statistical area 17 which includes such county. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall 18 provide such information to each county assessor each year as soon 19 as such information becomes available.

20 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional 21 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in 22 the following form:

1 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

2 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends Section 8C of Article 10. This section limits the fair cash 3 4 value of a homestead for individual head of households who are 5 sixty-five (65) years of age or older to not exceed the fair cash value placed upon the property during the first year in 6 7 which the individual head of household was sixty-five (65) years of age or older. Currently, this section only applies if the 8 9 individual head of household meets the age requirement and an 10 income limit determined by the United States Department of 11 Housing and Urban Development to be the estimated median income 12 for the preceding year for the county or metropolitan 13 statistical area which includes such county. This measure would 14 eliminate the required income limit. If this measure passes, 15 this section will apply if the individual head of household is 16 sixty-five (65) years of age or older.
