

1 Oklahoma by adding a new Section 4b to Article III thereof, to read
2 as follows:

3 A. In all elections held by the State Election Board, a county
4 election board, or a municipality, the following shall be required:

5 1. A candidate who receives the most votes at an election shall
6 be certified the winner of that election in the manner prescribed by
7 the Legislature;

8 2. Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the
9 authority of the Legislature to enact a mandatory primary system as
10 provided in Section 3 of Article III of this Constitution.

11 B. All elections held by the State Election Board, a county
12 election board, or a municipality shall be conducted in the
13 following manner:

14 1. A voter shall vote for only one candidate for the same
15 office;

16 2. A vote for one candidate shall not be reallocated to another
17 candidate for the same office; and

18 3. One voter's vote for a candidate for an office shall hold
19 the same weight as other voters' votes for a candidate for the same
20 office.

21 C. 1. This section shall remain in effect unless and until it
22 is repealed by a vote of the people by initiative or referendum as
23 provided in this Constitution.

2 referendum measure could only contain a provision to repeal this
3 section and could not contain an amendment to this section. The
4 Legislature would have the ability to enact laws in order to
5 implement the provisions of this section.
