8 and designating March 5th, 2024, as Susan G. Komen
9 Advocacy Day.

12 will be diagnosed in 2024 and more than 570 people will die of the
13 disease; and

14 WHEREAS, more than 4 million breast cancer survivors in the
15 U.S., those living with the disease and the people who love them can
16 attest to the urgent need of access to timely, affordable health
17 care - including genetic testing, screening, diagnosis and
18 treatment; and

19 WHEREAS, Susan G. Komen's vision is a world without breast
20 cancer; and

21 WHEREAS, Susan G. Komen's mission is to save lives by meeting
22 the most critical needs in our communities and investing in
23 breakthrough research to prevent and cure breast cancer; and

2 Honorable Eileen Echols annually through the Honorable Eileen Echols
3 Inspire award at the Oklahoma City Pink Tie Ball, to be held this
4 year on Saturday, April 20, 2024.
