8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Resolution declaring April 1 through 30, 2018, to
10 be National Poetry Month; and encouraging the
11 observance of National Poetry Month with appropriate
12 ceremonies, activities and programs.

13 WHEREAS, the Academy of American Poets established the month of
14 April as National Poetry Month in 1996; and

15 WHEREAS, National Poetry Month seeks to highlight the
16 extraordinary legacy and ongoing achievement of American poets,
17 introduce Americans to the pleasures and benefits of reading poetry,
18 bring poets and poetry to the public in immediate and innovative
19 ways and make poetry an important part of our children's education;

21 WHEREAS, National Poetry Month, under the leadership and
22 direction of the Academy of American Poets, is now the largest
23 literary celebration in the world; and

1 WHEREAS, poetry enhances and enriches the lives of all
2 Americans; and

3 WHEREAS, poetry, as an essential part of the arts and
4 humanities, affects every aspect of life in America today, including
5 education, the economy, and community pride and development; and

6 WHEREAS, poetry has produced some of the nation's leading
7 creative artists and has inspired other artists in fields such as
8 music, theatre, film, dance, and the visual arts.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
10 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

11 THAT April 1 through April 30, 2018, is hereby declared to be
12 National Poetry Month.

13 THAT public officials, educators, librarians, and all the people
14 of Oklahoma observe National Poetry Month, celebrate the cultural
15 richness of this state expressed in poetry, and recognize the
16 important role of poetry in creating and sustaining this great
17 nation and state with appropriate ceremonies, activities, and
18 programs.
