NEW LAW 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-148.1 of Title 70, unless 16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 A. Except as provided for in subsection B of this section, by 18 July 1, 2026, each school district in this state shall undergo a 19 risk and vulnerability assessment conducted by the Oklahoma School 20 Security Institute. The assessment shall include recommendations to 21 increase security on school district property. 22 B. A school district that underwent a risk and vulnerability 23 assessment conducted by the Oklahoma School Security Institute in 24

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the two (2) years prior to the effective date of this act shall be exempt from the provisions of subsection A of this section. C. After an initial risk and vulnerability assessment is conducted, school districts shall coordinate with the Oklahoma School Security Institute to conduct re-assessments every five (5) years. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023. SECTION 3.
