10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.42a of Title 62, unless there  
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 An agency director shall be authorized to place a percentage  
15 reduction or moratorium on pass-through funding during a fiscal year  
16 when the agency's total appropriations are less than the prior  
17 fiscal year's total appropriations. For purposes of this section,  
18 "pass-through funding" shall mean appropriated state dollars which  
19 have been historically allocated to any entity or organization as  
20 part of an annual budget and which are not:

- 21 1. Matched by federal funds;  
22 2. Payments for debt service; or  
23 3. Set out as a line item in any appropriations bill or  
24 legislation.

~~SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.~~

~~SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.~~
