6 An Act relating to emergency responders; creating the
7 Oklahoma Incident Management Team Advisory Committee;
8 setting duties and purpose; providing for membership;
9 providing that members receive no compensation or
10 travel reimbursement; providing for quorum; providing
11 for naming of chair; providing for frequency of
12 meetings; providing for codification; and providing
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-108.4 of Title 47, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. There is hereby created within the Oklahoma Department of
19 Public Safety the Oklahoma Incident Management Team Advisory
20 Committee. The purpose of the Committee shall be to:

21 1. Advise and assist the Commissioner in the development of
22 setting of goals, objectives and priorities with respect to state-
23 sponsored all-hazard emergency incident management team functions;

24 2. Advise and assist the Commissioner in establishing standards
and credentialing guidelines for emergency incident management

1 functions and responders within the Team Advisory Committee's scope
2 of authority; and

3 3. Provide a forum for discussion of issues between the
4 organizations within the Team Advisory Committee.

5 B. The Team Advisory Committee shall be composed of the
6 following seven (7) members as follows:

7 1. The Commissioner of Health, or designee;

8 2. The Director of the Oklahoma Forestry Services, or designee;

9 3. The Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Public
10 Safety, or designee;

11 4. The Director of the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security, or
12 designee;

13 5. The Director of the Office of Emergency Management, or
14 designee;

15 6. One member appointed by the Oklahoma Fire Chiefs Association
16 to represent a statewide association of fire chiefs in this state;
17 and

18 7. The Director of the Oklahoma State University Fire Safety
19 Training, or designee.

20 In addition to the seven (7) members, membership may be expanded
21 by a majority vote of the Committee.

22 C. The members of the Team Advisory Committee shall receive no
23 compensation or travel reimbursement.

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1 D. A majority of the Team Advisory Committee shall constitute a
2 quorum to transact official business.

3 E. The members of the Team Advisory Committee may elect from
4 among its membership a chair and vice chair to preside at all
5 meetings.

6 F. The Committee shall meet within ninety (90) days after the
7 effective date of this act and shall meet at least twice a year or
8 more frequently at the discretion of the chair.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
