13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-108.4 of Title 47, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. There is hereby created within the Oklahoma Department of
17	Public Safety the Oklahoma Incident Management Team Advisory

 - 1. The Commissioner of Health, or designee;
 - 2. The Director of the Oklahoma Forestry Services, or designee;
 - 3. The Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Public

- 4. The Director of the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security, or designee;
- 5. The Director of the Office of Emergency Management, or designee;
- 6. One member appointed by the Oklahoma Fire Chiefs Association to represent a statewide association of fire chiefs in this state;

- 7. The Director of the Oklahoma State University Fire Safety
 Training, or designee.
- In addition to the seven (7) members, membership may be expanded by a majority vote of the Committee.
- C. The members of the Team Advisory Committee shall receive no compensation or travel reimbursement.

1	D. A majority of the Team Advisory Committee shall constitute a
2	quorum to transact official business.
3	E. The members of the Team Advisory Committee may elect from
4	among its membership a chair and vice chair to preside at all
5	meetings.
6	F. The Committee shall meet within ninety (90) days after the
7	effective date of this act and shall meet at least twice a year or
8	more frequently at the discretion of the chair.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
