SENATE BILL 1031

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring certain schools that administer certain survey to include certain affidavit; defining term; requiring third parties that administer certain survey to include certain affidavit; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-160 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning in the 2023-2024 school year, a school district, public charter school, or virtual charter school that administers any survey shall include as part of the survey an affidavit verifying that administration of the survey and the collection of survey responses complies with the Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment, 20 U.S.C. Section 1232h. For the purposes of this section, "survey" means any questionnaire, data collection, risk assessment, or solicitation of information from students used to assess home environment, political or philosophical ideology,

1 religion, political affiliation, information about families, gender
2 orientation, sexual orientation, safety or risk, drug use, or health
3 including vaccination status. "Survey" does not mean an academic
4 assessment.

5 B. If a school district, public charter school, or virtual
6 charter school contracts with a third party to administer a survey
7 and collect survey responses, the third party shall include the
8 affidavit required by subsection A of this section.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
