7 An Act relating to the Department of Mental Health
8 and Substance Abuse Services; requiring that portions
9 of certain appropriated funds be used for certain
10 purposes; requiring certain funds to be used to
11 maintain pilot programs; authorizing request for
early transfers of certain funds for specific
purpose; providing for lapse of funds under certain
conditions; requiring certain budget procedures; and
prohibiting certain budget procedures.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
16 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
17 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
18 sum of Two Million Six Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Eight Hundred
19 Fifty-three Dollars (\$2,621,853.00) shall be used for program
20 growth.

21 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
22 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
23 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
24 sum of Two Million Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-nine

1 Dollars (\$2,017,579.00) shall be used to replace funding no longer
2 available due to the reduction of federal matching dollars.

3 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
4 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
5 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
6 sum of Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000.00) shall be used to
7 implement targeted provider rate increases.

8 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
9 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
10 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
11 sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall be used to increase
12 funding for services for children with acute behavioral health
13 issues.

14 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
15 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
16 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
17 sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) shall be used to
18 expand services for veterans and their families.

19 SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
20 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
21 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
22 sum of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000.00)
23 shall be used to expand the number of beds at the Oklahoma Forensic
24 Center located in Vinita, Oklahoma.

1 SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
2 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
3 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
4 sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be used to expand
5 the family treatment court program.

6 SECTION 8. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
7 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services in Enrolled Senate Bill
8 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
9 sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used to
10 maintain five pilot programs to provide offenders incarcerated in
11 county jails in the State of Oklahoma access to United States Food
12 and Drug Administration-approved, evidence-based, medication-
13 assisted treatment for opioid and alcohol dependence. Treatment may
14 be administered while the inmate is confined in the county jail and
15 when participating in outpatient care upon release. Funding may
16 only be used for medical evaluations, the purchase of United States
17 Food and Drug Administration-approved medication to treat opioid or
18 alcohol dependency, individual and group counseling services,
19 cognitive behavioral therapies and necessary medical and behavioral
20 health staff needed to maintain the program.

21 SECTION 9. The Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health
22 and Substance Abuse Services may request through the Director of the
23 Office of Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by
24 the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General

1 Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's
2 disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

3 SECTION 10. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No.
4 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not
5 including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be
6 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23)
7 or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024
8 (hereafter FY-24). Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only
9 through June 30, 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023.
10 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for
11 FY-24, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
12 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered
13 only through June 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15,
14 2024, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then
15 current fiscal year. These appropriations shall not be budgeted in
16 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not
17 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
18 for FY-24, after the agency to which the funds have been
19 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
20 revision removing these funds from the FY-23 budget work program and
21 after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management
22 and Enterprise Services.

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
