7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and
8 Recreation Department; requiring matching funds be
9 used for certain purpose; requiring matching funds be
10 equal in amount to previous fiscal year; authorizing
11 the expenditure of certain funds in certain amounts
12 for certain purposes; providing for lapse of funds
13 under certain conditions; and requiring and
14 prohibiting certain budget procedures.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism
17 and Recreation Department in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the
18 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department shall
19 make available matching funds to multicounty organizations pursuant
20 to Section 2234 of Title 74 of Oklahoma Statutes. The matching
21 funds made available shall be equal in amount to the funds made
22 available in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

23 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism
24 and Recreation Department in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the
25 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department is
26 hereby authorized to expend Three Hundred Sixty-one Thousand Three

1 Hundred Twenty-two Dollars (\$361,322.00) for employee pay raises for
2 CLEET-certified employees within the division of State Parks.

3 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism
4 and Recreation Department in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the
5 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department is
6 hereby authorized to expend Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand Sixty-
7 three Dollars (\$880,063.00) for additional employee compensation for
8 those employees that are earning below-market salaries for their
9 positions.

10 SECTION 4. Appropriations made to the Oklahoma Tourism and
11 Recreation Department by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd
12 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
13 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23), or may be
15 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
16 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
17 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
18 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
19 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
20 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June
21 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse
22 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
23 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years
24 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay

1 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after
2 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
3 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
4 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been
5 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
