3 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism 4 and Recreation Department in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 5 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department is 6 hereby authorized to expend Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand Sixty-7 three Dollars (\$880,063.00) for additional employee compensation for 8 those employees that are earning below-market salaries for their 9 positions.

SECTION 4. Appropriations made to the Oklahoma Tourism and 10 Recreation Department by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd 11 12 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23), or may be 14 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24). 15 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30, 16 17 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall 18 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 19 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 20 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse 21 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 22 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years 23 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay 24
