9	An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S. 2011, Section 8-116, which relates to certain city
10	managers and city planners; deleting obsolete reference to financial assistance; and declaring an

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 8-116, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 8-116. A. Any municipality with a population of less
18	than five thousand (5,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial
19	Census may employ a part-time city manager or a part-time city
20	planner. The duties of the part-time city manager shall be
21	determined by the governing body of the municipality, or pursuant to
22	Section 10-113 of this title for municipalities governed by the
23	council-manager form of government. The duties of the part-time
24	

1	city planner shall be determined by the governing body of the
2	municipality.
3	B. Financial assistance for qualifying municipalities may be
4	obtained, upon availability of funding, through a financial
5	assistance program to be developed by the Oklahoma Department of
6	Commerce authorized pursuant to Section 5017 of Title 74 of the
7	Oklahoma Statutes.
8	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
