6 An Act relating to student transfers; amending 70
7 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, which relates to
8 eligibility of student transfers in extramural
9 competitions; updating statutory reference; providing
10 certain exception to certain students who previously
11 attended a charter school and participated in the
12 charter school's competitions; providing an effective
13 date; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 8-103.2. A. Except as otherwise provided, a student
18 who enrolls, pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act or pursuant
19 to ~~Section 2 of this act~~ Section 8-113 of this title, in a school
20 district in which the student is not a resident shall not be
21 eligible to participate in school-related extramural athletic
22 competition governed by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities
23 Association for a period of one (1) year from the first day of
24 attendance at the receiving school unless the transfer is from a
school district which does not offer the grade the student is
entitled to pursue.

1 B. If the student is granted an emergency transfer pursuant to
2 Section 8-104 of this title, was granted a transfer for any reason
3 prior to January 1, 2000, or enrolls pursuant to the Education Open
4 Transfer Act and qualifies for a hardship waiver pursuant to the
5 rules of the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association,
6 eligibility to participate in school-related extramural athletic
7 competition shall be determined by the Oklahoma Secondary School
8 Activities Association.

9 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not
10 apply to a student who:

11 1. Was enrolled in a charter school established pursuant to
12 Section 3-132 of this title;

13 2. Was participating in the charter school's extramural
14 athletic competitions; and

15 3. Transfers to a public school district after the charter
16 school in which the student was enrolled ceases to operate for any
17 reason.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
