6 An Act relating to odometers; amending 47 O.S. 2011,
7 Section 12-506, which relates to violation and
8 penalty of the Odometer Setting Act; creating civil
9 liability for certain violation; authorizing award of
10 certain costs and fees; providing an effective date;
11 and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 12-506, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 12-506. Any person convicted of violating any of the
16 provisions of the Odometer Setting Act with intent to misrepresent
17 the true mileage driven of a motor vehicle shall be guilty of a
18 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than Ten
19 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or imprisonment for not more than one
20 (1) year, or by both fine and imprisonment. A person violating the
21 provisions of the Odometer Setting Act shall have civil liability
22 for the greater of three times the actual damages or One Thousand
23 Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Additionally, the court may award
24 court costs and attorney fees to the prevailing party in a civil
action.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
