AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 12-506, is 13 amended to read as follows: Section 12-506. Any person convicted of violating any of the 14 15 provisions of the Odometer Setting Act with intent to misrepresent the true mileage driven of a motor vehicle shall be guilty of a 16 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than Ten 17 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or imprisonment for not more than one 18 (1) year, or by both fine and imprisonment. A person violating the 19 provisions of the Odometer Setting Act shall have civil liability 20 for the greater of three times the actual damages or One Thousand 21 Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Additionally, the court may award 22 23 court costs and attorney fees to the prevailing party in a civil 24 action.

3	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
