9 An Act relating to odometers; amending 47 O.S. 2011,  
10 Section 12-506, which relates to violation and  
11 penalty of the Odometer Setting Act; creating civil  
12 liability for certain violation; authorizing award of  
13 certain costs and fees; providing an effective date;  
14 and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 12-506, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 12-506. Any person convicted of violating any of the  
19 provisions of the Odometer Setting Act with intent to misrepresent  
20 the true mileage driven of a motor vehicle shall be guilty of a  
21 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than Ten  
22 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or imprisonment for not more than one  
23 (1) year, or by both fine and imprisonment. A person violating the  
24 provisions of the Odometer Setting Act shall have civil liability  
for the greater of three times the actual damages or One Thousand

1 Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Additionally, the court may award  
2 court costs and attorney fees to the prevailing party in a civil  
3 action.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
