AMENDATORY amended to read as follows: 16 Section 12-506. Any person convicted of violating any of the 17 provisions of the Odometer Setting Act with intent to misrepresent 18 the true mileage driven of a motor vehicle shall be guilty of a 19 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than Ten 20 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or imprisonment for not more than one 21 (1) year, or by both fine and imprisonment. A person violating the 22 23 provisions of the Odometer Setting Act shall have civil liability for the greater of three times the actual damages or One Thousand 24

1	Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Additionally, the court may award
2	court costs and attorney fees to the prevailing party in a civil
3	action.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.
5	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
