There is hereby appropriated to the Office of 15 Management and Enterprise Services from any monies not otherwise 16 appropriated from the Oklahoma Capital Assets Maintenance and 17 Protection Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Fifty-six Million 18 Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$56,250,000.00) or so much 19 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the 20 Office of Management and Enterprise Services by law. 21 SECTION 2. The funds appropriated pursuant to Section 1 of this 22 act shall be expended pursuant to a plan submitted by the Office of 23 Management and Enterprise Services not later than May 31, 2024, to 24

2	Senate and the Chair of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of
3	the Oklahoma House of Representatives.
4	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
5	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
