10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028.2 of Title 63, unless there  
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall initiate requests  
15 for proposals for a pilot program to examine the feasibility of  
16 transforming the current Medicaid program from a fee-for-service  
17 payment model to a value-based payment model utilizing a provider-  
18 led accountable care organization. The pilot program shall begin no  
19 later than January 1, 2022.

20 B. The pilot program implemented by the accountable care  
21 organization shall contain, but not be limited to, the following  
22 components:

- 23 1. Value-based purchasing;  
24 2. Quality measurements;

- 1        3. Data-sharing and integration;
- 2        4. Care management;
- 3        5. Provider and community collaboration; and
- 4        6. Preservation of the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment
- 5 Program.

6        C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate  
7 rules to implement the provisions of this act.

8        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
