6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Highway Construction  
7 Materials Technician Registration Act; amending 69  
8 O.S. 2021, Section 1963, which relates to the Highway  
9 Construction Materials Technician Certification Board  
10 Revolving Fund; renaming Fund; adding use for Fund;  
11 repealing 69 O.S. 2021, Sections 1951, 1952, 1953,  
12 1954, 1955, 1956, 1957, 1958, 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962,  
13 and 1964, which relate to certain definitions, the  
14 Highway Construction Materials Technician  
15 Certification Board, membership, rules, and powers  
16 and duties of the Board, examinations, requirements,  
17 and issuance of certificates, revocation and  
18 suspension of certificates, independence of Board  
19 from the Department of Transportation, and the  
20 liability of the Board and its members; and providing  
21 an effective date.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1963, is  
24 amended to read as follows:

Section 1963. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a  
revolving fund to be designated the "Highway Construction Materials  
Technician Certification ~~Board~~ Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a  
continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
consist of all monies received ~~by the Board~~ for deposit in the fund.  
All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby

1 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended ~~by the Board~~ for the  
2 purpose of conducting training ~~and examination and the execution of~~  
3 ~~the powers and duties of the Board as set forth in this act~~ or  
4 certification of individuals seeking to become registered as a  
5 highway construction materials technician. Expenditures from the  
6 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer  
7 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the  
8 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and  
9 payment.

10 SECTION 2. REPEALER 69 O.S. 2021, Sections 1951, 1952,  
11 1953, 1954, 1955, 1956, 1957, 1958, 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962, and  
12 1964, are hereby repealed.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
