AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1963, is 24 amended to read as follows:

1	Section 1963. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
2	revolving fund to be designated the "Highway Construction Materials
3	Technician Certification Board Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
4	continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
5	consist of all monies received by the Board for deposit in the fund.
6	All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
7	appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Board
8	Department of Transportation for the purpose of conducting training
9	and examination and the execution of the powers and duties of the
10	Board as set forth in this act or certification of individuals
11	seeking to become registered as highway construction materials
12	technicians. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
13	issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
14	law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
15	Services for approval and payment.
16	SECTION 2. REPEALER 69 O.S. 2021, Sections 1951, 1952,
17	1953, 1954, 1955, 1956, 1957, 1958, 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962, and
18	1964, are hereby repealed.
19	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
