An Act relating to the Oklahoma Highway Construction Materials Technician Registration Act; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1963, which relates to the Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification Board Revolving Fund; renaming fund; modifying entity responsible for fund; adding use for fund; repealing 69 O.S. 2021, Sections 1951, 1952, 1953, 1954, 1955, 1956, 1957, 1958, 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962, and 1964, which relate to certain definitions, the Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification Board, membership, rules, powers, and duties of the Board, examinations, requirements, and issuance of certificates, revocation and suspension of certificates, independence of Board from the Department of Transportation, and the liability of the Board and its members; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Oklahoma Highway Construction Materials Technician Registration Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1963, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1963. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund to be designated the "Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification ~~Board~~ Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall

consist of all monies received ~~by the Board~~ for deposit in the fund. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the ~~Board~~ Department of Transportation for the purpose of conducting training ~~and examination and the execution of the powers and duties of the Board as set forth in this act~~ or certification of individuals seeking to become registered as highway construction materials technicians. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 69 O.S. 2021, Sections 1951, 1952, 1953, 1954, 1955, 1956, 1957, 1958, 1959, 1960, 1961, 1962, and 1964, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
