6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to career and technology education;
8 creating a task force to study and make
9 recommendations regarding funding; establishing
10 expiration date, providing for membership and
11 providing for naming of chair; requiring appointments
12 by certain date; requiring organizational meeting by
13 certain date; specifying quorum; providing for
14 frequency of meetings; subjecting meetings to the
15 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act; prohibiting compensation
16 or travel reimbursement for members; providing for
17 staff support; requiring submission of certain report
18 by certain date; providing for codification;
19 providing an effective date; and declaring an
20 emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-103.5 of Title 70, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created until July 1, 2019, a task force to
study and make recommendations to the Legislature on improving
funding for career and technology education.

B. The task force shall be comprised of five (5) members to be
appointed as follows:

- 1 1. One member who represents the business community, appointed
2 by the Governor;
- 3 2. The Chair of the Oklahoma State Senate Appropriations
4 Committee, or designee;
- 5 3. One member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
6 Appropriations and Budget committee, or designee;
- 7 4. The Director of the Oklahoma Board of Career and Technology
8 Education, or designee; and
- 9 5. The Secretary of the Education and Workforce Development, or
10 designee.

11 The Chair of the task force shall be the Director of the
12 Oklahoma Board of Career and Technology Education, or designee.

13 C. Appointments to the task force shall be made within thirty
14 (30) days after the effective date of this act. The task force
15 shall conduct an organizational meeting not later than August 31,
16 2018.

17 D. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any
18 final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, three
19 members shall constitute a quorum.

20 E. The task force may meet as often as may be required in order
21 to perform the duties imposed upon it.

22 F. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to the
23 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

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1 G. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or
2 travel reimbursement.

3 H. The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education
4 shall provide staff and administrative support for the task force.

5 I. The task force shall submit a report of its findings and
6 recommendations by July 1, 2019, to the Governor, the President Pro
7 Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
8 Representatives.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
