7 An Act relating to lemon law vehicles; amending 15
8 O.S. 2011, Section 901.1, which relates to
9 manufacturer buyback responsibilities; modifying
10 language; making title branding permanent; and
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 15 O.S. 2011, Section 901.1, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 901.1. Any manufacturer who reacquires or assists a
16 dealer or lienholder to reacquire a motor vehicle registered in this
17 state, prior to any sale, lease, or transfer of the vehicle in this
18 state, or prior to exporting the vehicle to another state for sale,
19 lease, or transfer if the vehicle was registered in this state and
20 reacquired pursuant to this ~~law~~ section or Section 901 of this title
21 shall:

22 1. Cause the vehicle to be retitled in the name of the
23 manufacturer; and

1 2. Request the Oklahoma Tax Commission to brand the certificate
2 of title with the notation "Lemon Law Buyback". Any branding of a
3 title as a "Lemon Law Buyback" shall remain permanently on the
4 title.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
