6	An Act relating to the practice of psychology;
7	amending 59 O.S. 2021, Sections 1354 and 1357, which relate to the State Board of Examiners of
8	Psychologists; removing certain limitation on appointees; and providing an effective date.

11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1354, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 1354. There is hereby re-created, to continue until
15	July 1, 2023, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law,
16	the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists. The Board shall
17	administer the provisions of the Psychologists Licensing Act. The
18	Board shall consist of seven (7) members appointed by the Governor.
19	Five members shall be psychologists from various areas in psychology
20	and two members shall be lay persons. At the expiration of the term
21	of each Board member who is a psychologist , the Governor shall
22	appoint a successor from a list of ten licensed psychologists which
23	is provided by the Oklahoma State Psychological Association.
24	Members shall serve for a term of four (4) years and until a

1	successor is appointed and qualified. Before entering upon the
2	duties of office, each member of the Board shall take the
3	constitutional oath of office and file it with the Secretary of
4	State.
5	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1357, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Section 1357. After giving the member a written statement of
8	the charges and an opportunity to be heard thereon, the Governor may
9	remove any member of the Board for misconduct, incompetency, or
10	neglect of duty. Any vacancy in the membership of the Board shall
11	be filled by the Governor for the unexpired term. If there is a
12	vacancy in the psychologist membership of the Board, the Governor
13	shall fill it from a list of ten (10) psychologists which is
14	provided by the Oklahoma State Psychological Association.
15	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
