19	the following public assistance programs:
20	1. The state Medicaid program;
21	2. The Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program;
22	3. The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP); and
23	4. The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women,
24	Infants, and Children (WIC).

1 B. At a minimum, the application shall: 2 1. Be user-friendly and available in multiple languages; 3 2. Enable applicants to complete and electronically submit 4 applications; and 5 3. Allow for the secure transmission of data among relevant 6 agencies for eligibility and enrollment in the programs listed in 7 subsection A of this section. 8 C. The agencies responsible for administering the programs 9 listed in subsection A of this section shall collaborate to 10 establish protocols and systems for sharing information securely and 11 efficiently between agencies while maintaining privacy and 12 confidentiality. 13 The Director of the Department of Human Services, the 14 Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board, and the State Commissioner of 15 Health may promulgate rules as necessary to implement the provisions 16 of this section. 17 SECTION 2.
