Each bidder shall accompany the bid with a written 14 15 statement under oath disclosing the following information: The nature of any partnership, joint venture, or other 16 business relationships then in effect or which existed within one 17 (1) year prior to the date of such statement with the architect, 18 engineer, or other party to the project; 19 20 2. Any such business relationship then in effect or which existed within one (1) year prior to the date of such statement 21 between any officer or director of the bidding company and any 22 officer or director of the architectural or engineering firm or 23

1	3. The names of all persons having any such business
2	relationships and the positions they hold with their respective
