7 An Act relating to health insurance; creating the
8 State Innovation Waiver; allowing for multiple waiver
9 submissions; establishing certain procedures for
10 development; requiring certain entities to submit
11 information for approval; authorizing the Insurance
12 Department to review health insurance market after
13 waiver implementation; providing for codification;
14 and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1416 of Title 36, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. There is hereby authorized the creation and submission of a
20 State Innovation Waiver for the purpose of creating Oklahoma health
21 insurance products that improve health and health care quality while
22 controlling costs.

23 B. The State Innovation Waiver may include multiple waiver
24 submissions under federal waiver authorities, including Section
25 1332, 1115, and 1915 waivers.

1 C. The State Innovation Waiver shall be created consistent with
2 the innovation design plan developed through the Oklahoma Health
3 Improvement Plan. It shall be presented to the Oklahoma Legislature
4 along with a summary of comments received from public hearings and
5 shall include the identification of specific provisions of the
6 Affordable Care Act to be waived in the State of Oklahoma.

7 D. Participating agencies, including but not limited to the
8 State Department of Health, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, the
9 Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and the
10 Insurance Department, shall develop the State Innovation Waiver and
11 submit any and all necessary information for approval to all
12 relevant entities.

13 E. The Insurance Department is hereby authorized to conduct
14 rate review for the individual and small group health insurance
15 market upon implementation of the State Innovation Waiver under
16 Section 1332.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.

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
