11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2204, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 2204. All Except as otherwise provided in this section,
14	all revenues collected pursuant to the provisions of Section 2201 et
15	seq. of this title shall be paid by the Tax Commission to the State
16	Treasurer and placed to the credit of the Oklahoma Department of
17	Transportation in the Railroad Maintenance Revolving Fund for the
18	implementation of the Railroad Revitalization Act or for matching of
19	available federal funds for at-grade railroad crossing protection
20	projects. Such crossing projects must be authorized by the
21	Transportation Commission. <u>Provided, in no event shall the revenue</u>
22	apportioned pursuant to this section exceed the 3-year average of
23	the total fiscal year amounts apportioned in fiscal years 2015, 2016

1	and 2017. Any amount in excess of the 3-year average shall be
2	placed to the credit of the General Revenue Fund.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
4	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
