- B. The memorial sign shall bear the words "Please Don't Drink and Drive. In Memory of" along with the victim's name and the date of the accident. The applicant shall provide an official document showing that the accident was a result of impaired driving.
- C. The cost associated with signage related to the Victims of Impaired Driving Memorial Sign Program shall be paid by the applicant requesting the sign. The sign shall be installed only after the application has been approved and the cost has been collected. The Department of Transportation shall promulgate rules establishing a procedure to assess and collect the cost of the sign. The cost of the sign shall be based on an average of the cost of signs erected during the preceding fiscal year, as reported by the Department of Transportation.
- D. An installed sign shall remain in place for a period of one year. At the end of that period, the sign shall be offered back to the applicant. The applicant shall have thirty (30) days from the time contacted to make arrangements to pick up the sign. After that time period, the sign shall be recycled.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
