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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:					
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.7, is					
14	amended to read as follows:					
15	Section 1135.7. A. Beginning January 1, 2006, the The Oklahoma					
16	Tax Commission is authorized to design and issue special license					
17	plates to any person that applies to the Tax Commission for the					
18	creation of a special license plate and meets the minimum standards					
19	and qualifications specified in this section.					
20	B. If the following standards and guidelines are satisfied, the					
21	Tax Commission shall issue a special license plate to the person					
22	making application for the special license plate:					
23	1. The license plate is to:					
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1 show membership in or affiliation with an a. 2 organization, or 3 b. demonstrate support for an organization, group or cause; 4 5 2. The license plate does not advertise or endorse a product, brand, or service that is provided for sale; 6 7 3. The license plate does not promote any philosophy based on prejudice or that is contrary to state civil rights laws; and 8 9 4. Five hundred prepaid applications for the special license plate are received by the Tax Commission; provided, one hundred 10 11 prepaid applications shall be required for applications for a 12 special license plate which is in support of a university alumni 13 association.

C. The fee for special license plates that do not provide 14 financial assistance shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) and shall be 15 in addition to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma 16 Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in 17 this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows: 18 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be deposited 19 in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the 20 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act 21 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the special license plate 22 fee shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104 of Title 47 of 23 the Oklahoma Statutes. 24

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D. The fee for special license plates that provide financial assistance shall be Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to
the License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving Fund created
in Section 7 of this act to be used in the manner detailed in the
application for the special license plate;

2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
 and

3. Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the fee shall be apportioned asprovided in Section 1104 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

E. If a person applies for a special license plate that provides financial assistance, the application shall designate a state agency to be responsible for expending the funds generated by the special license plate and the application shall designate a specific public purpose for which the funds are to be used.

F. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

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on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
issued on a staggered system.

10 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 11 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept applications for special license plates authorized under this 12 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 13 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 14 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 15 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 16 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 17 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of Title 47 of the 18 Oklahoma Statutes for registration of a motor vehicle. The motor 19 license agent fees for acceptance of applications and renewals shall 20 be paid out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. 21

G. All special plates issued by the Tax Commission prior to the effective date of this act November 1, 2005, shall not be subject to the requirements and qualifications outlined in this section.

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H. As used in this section, "person" includes an individual,
 group, organization or not-for-profit corporation that is recognized
 as such by the Internal Revenue Service.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.28 of Title 47, unless 6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
8 1135.5 of this title for the Kansas State University License Plate
9 shall be deposited in the Kansas State University License Plate
10 Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

11 Β. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 12 fund for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to be designated the "Kansas State University License Plate Revolving 13 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal 14 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the 15 Office of Management and Enterprise Services pursuant to the 16 provisions of subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to 17 the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted 18 and expended by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for 19 grants to the Kansas State University Alumni Association for the 20 purpose of providing scholarships. Expenditures from the fund shall 21 be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims 22 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of 23 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 24
