12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2011, Section 98, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 98. All domestic animals shall be restrained by the
16	owner thereof at all times and seasons of the year from running at
17	large in the State of Oklahoma. Damages caused by the domestic
18	animals trespassing upon lands of another shall be recovered in a
19	manner provided by law. For the purpose of this act, domestic
20	animals shall include cattle, horses, swine, sheep, goats, exotic
21	livestock <u>, dogs,</u> and all other animals not considered wild <del>. The</del>
22	term "domestic animals" shall not include domestic house pets.
23	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2011, Section 99, is
24	amended to read as follows:

- Section 99. A. Any person who:

Willfully omits to keep a domestic animal such person owns
 or has charge of within a suitable enclosure;

Allows the animal to be unrestrained or to run at large,
 with notice, actual or constructive, that the enclosure within which
 the animal is kept is open; or

3. Knowingly causes a domestic animal to escape confinement, 7 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction 8 9 thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars 10 (\$50.00), or not more than thirty (30) days' imprisonment in the county jail, or by both fine and imprisonment for each the first 11 12 offense. For a second or subsequent offense, a person shall be 13 punished by a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or not more than thirty (30) days' imprisonment in the county jail for each 14 15 offense, or by both fine and imprisonment.

16 B. For the purpose of this act, the term "domestic animals"
17 shall not include domestic house pets.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
