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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to special license plates; amending  
8 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1104.11, as amended by Section  
9 189, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014,  
10 Section 1104.11), which relates to the Patriot  
License Plate Revolving Fund; modifying purpose for  
which funds may be expended; and declaring an  
emergency.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1104.11, as  
15 amended by Section 189, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp.  
16 2014, Section 1104.11), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1104.11. A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee  
18 authorized by Section 1135.5 of this title for the Patriot License  
19 Plate shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund  
20 created in subsection B of this section.

21 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
22 fund for the Military Department of Oklahoma to be designated the  
23 "Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a  
24 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall

1 consist of all monies received by the Military Department of  
2 Oklahoma pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section.  
3 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
4 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Military  
5 Department of Oklahoma for any deployment-related purpose ~~for~~  
6 ~~Oklahoma residents who are members of the Oklahoma National Guard~~  
7 including, but not limited to, the production of historical  
8 documents, displays, videos, and books that capture the National  
9 Guard's involvement in overseas deployments and domestic operations  
10 within the United States for members of the Oklahoma National Guard,  
11 Oklahoma public school libraries, and civic leaders, as determined  
12 by the Adjutant General. Expenditures from the fund shall be made  
13 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as  
14 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and  
15 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

16 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
