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10 An Act relating to special license plates; amending
11 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1104.11, as amended by Section
12 189, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014,
13 Section 1104.11), which relates to the Patriot
14 License Plate Revolving Fund; modifying purpose for
15 which funds may be expended; and declaring an
16 emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1104.11, as
19 amended by Section 189, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp.
20 2014, Section 1104.11), is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1104.11 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee
22 authorized by Section 1135.5 of this title for the Patriot License
23 Plate shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund
24 created in subsection B of this section.

B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
fund for the Military Department of Oklahoma to be designated the

1 "Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
2 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
3 consist of all monies received by the Military Department of
4 Oklahoma pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section.
5 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
6 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Military
7 Department of Oklahoma for any deployment-related purpose for
8 ~~Oklahoma residents who are~~ members of the Oklahoma National Guard or
9 the production of historical documents, displays, videos, and books
10 that capture the National Guard's involvement in overseas
11 deployments and domestic operations within the United States for
12 members of the Oklahoma National Guard, Oklahoma public school
13 libraries, and civic leaders, as determined by the Adjutant General.
14 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
15 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
16 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
17 approval and payment.

18 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
