Nothing herein shall be construed to constitute a guarantee or assumption by the State of Oklahoma of any debt of any individual, company, corporation, or association nor to authorize the credit of the State of Oklahoma to be given, pledged or loaned to any individual, company, corporation or association.
- B. It is the finding of the Legislature that it is beneficial to this state and its citizens to provide enhanced economic development incentives to certain establishments including, but not limited to, those associated with an industry that has not previously been significantly active in this state or which create a substantial number of jobs or make a substantial investment in this state, as such economic activity results in a greater direct benefit to the state.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
