B. The court shall have jurisdiction to provide such relief as
may be appropriate. Any relief granted by the court to enforce an
order under subsection A of this section shall continue in effect
until the completion or final termination of all proceedings for
review of such order is made, unless the district court granting
such relief sets it aside or modifies it.

C. Any person willfully violating any rule, regulation, or 14 order of the OEM an emergency management director with authority in 15 that jurisdiction and acting in his or her capacity as such shall be 16 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall, upon conviction thereof, 17 be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six 18 (6) months, or by a fine  $\overline{of}$  not more than Three Thousand Dollars 19 (\$3,000.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine. Each day of 20 violation shall constitute a separate offense. 21

D. The Department of Public Safety, the Oklahoma State Bureau
 of Investigation, and the Oklahoma Tax Commission Any certified law
 enforcement officer in the state shall assist the OEM an emergency
