14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-103.1 of Title 26, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Beginning with the 2025 election cycle, elections for any
18	county office shall be conducted on a nonpartisan basis. Candidates
19	for a county office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy with the
20	secretary of the county election board as provided in Section 5-103
21	of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes but shall not declare a party
22	affiliation.
23	B. If more than two candidates qualify to have their names
24 27	appear on the ballot for a county office, the names of all such

1 candidates shall appear on the Primary Election ballot. If no 2 single candidate receives more than fifty percent (50%) of the votes 3 cast at the Primary Election, the names of the two candidates 4 receiving the highest number of votes at the Primary Election shall 5 appear on the General Election ballot. 6 If only two candidates qualify to have their names appear on С. 7 the ballot for a county office, the names of both candidates shall 8 appear on the General Election ballot. 9 SECTION 2.
