No later than July 1, 2023, all state agencies, 15 institutions, or political subdivisions shall choose and contract 16 with a third-party evaluator on the Oklahoma Statewide Contracts to 17 perform a thorough evaluation and report of the individual agency's 18 document lifecycle needs and costs, inclusive of digital forms, 19 workflow and eProcesses, storage, retrieval, destruction, and 20 digital auditing. 21 B. Upon completion of the third-party evaluation, each agency 22 shall submit the reported findings and any subsequent actions taken 23

by the agency to improve efficiency and productivity, while reducing
