6 An Act relating to state agencies; requiring certain  
7 third-party evaluation of agency processes; requiring  
8 report upon completion of evaluation; directing  
9 distribution of report; providing for codification;  
10 and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 80.2 of Title 74, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. No later than July 1, 2023, all state agencies,  
16 institutions, or political subdivisions shall choose and contract  
17 with a third-party evaluator on the Oklahoma Statewide Contracts to  
18 perform a thorough evaluation and report of the individual agency's  
19 document lifecycle needs and costs, inclusive of digital forms,  
20 workflow and eProcesses, storage, retrieval, destruction, and  
21 digital auditing.

22 B. Upon completion of the third-party evaluation, each agency  
23 shall submit the reported findings and any subsequent actions taken  
24 by the agency to improve efficiency and productivity, while reducing

1 overall cost through technological improvements to the President Pro  
2 Tempore of the Senate and to the Speaker of the House of  
3 Representatives no later than November 1, 2023.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
