SENATE BILL 1553

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to renewable energy; establishing legislative intent; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 800 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. It is the intent of the Legislature that the State of Oklahoma encourage and promote the development of renewable energy resources to ensure the development of reliable, economic, and long-term sources of energy supply and to promote efficiencies in generation, storage, transmission, and utilization of electric energy.

B. For the purposes of this section, "renewable energy" means energy produced from wind, solar, hydrogen, hydroelectric power, nuclear, geothermal energy, and biofuels.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
