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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
17	Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
18	Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Sixty-
19	five Million Eight Hundred Sixty-five Thousand Eighty-eight Dollars
20	(\$65,865,088.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the
21	financial support of public schools.
22	SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including
23	appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
24	the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17), or may be

1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18). 2 Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June 30, 3 2017, and must be expended by November 15, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, and not budgeted for FY-18, shall 4 5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 6 7 30, 2018. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2018, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 8 9 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 10 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-17, and not required to pay 11 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-18, after 12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 13 from the FY-17 budget work program and after such revision has been 14 15 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016. 16 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby 18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 20 21 DIRECT TO CALENDAR.
