10	An Act relating to appropriations; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Career
11	and Technology Education; stating purpose; providing
12	lapse dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures; and declaring an emergency.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
17	Department of Career and Technology Education from any monies not
18	otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
19	Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, the sum of One
20	Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
21	necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department
22	of Career and Technology Education by law.
23	SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including
24	appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20). 2 Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June 30, 3 2019, and must be expended by November 15, 2019. Any funds 4 5 remaining after November 15, 2019, and not budgeted for FY-20, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 6 year. Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 7 30, 2020. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2020, shall lapse 8 9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-19, and not required to pay 11 12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-20, after 13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 14 from the FY-19 budget work program and after such revision has been 15 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. 16 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 20 21

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
